

## **The BAR Association of DC and Foundation Announce the 132<sup>nd</sup> Annual Banquet Awardees**

Associate Justice Sandra Day O'Connor will receive The Judicial Honoree of the Year Award at the 132<sup>nd</sup> Annual Banquet of The Bar Association of the District of Columbia on Saturday, December 6, 2003 at the new "Blue Room" of the Omni Shoreham Hotel. Justice O'Connor was selected as this year's honoree for her unique role in American history as the first woman to serve as a Justice of the United States Supreme Court and for her many years of distinguished public and judicial service.

The coveted "Lawyer of the Year" award will be conferred posthumously on Charles L. "Chuck" Reischel, Deputy Corporation Counsel, Appellate Division, Office of the District of Columbia Corporation Counsel. Mr. Reischel's spouse, Nancy E. Stanley, Director of Dispute Resolution for the US Courts of DC, will accept the award on his behalf.
